- Investigate how evidence-based practice and research impact orthopaedic patient outcomes.
- Maintain a professional environment that encourages collegiality and networking among participants associated with advancement in orthopaedic nursing education, practice, and research.

Submission Deadline

Podium Presentation Proposals are due by **March 31, 2017** with notification of acceptance/decline in July of 2017.

Please note: There will be no deadline extensions for 2018 proposal submissions.

Honorarium

All presenters are eligible for a modest honorarium. Travel and housing arrangements are the responsibility of each presenter.

Podium Presentation Proposals

Podium presentation proposals require a title, practice gap, learner outcome, a summary of the content, and current references supporting the education proposed.

Research podium proposals also should include background, problem and purpose, methodology, sample, results, limitations, conclusions, and implications. *A research study **must be completed** before submitting it as a podium proposal.*

Selection consideration is given to the following: proposal appearance and completion; Outcome; content; innovation; evidence-based content; relevance to orthopaedic nursing; support for the AAOS/NAON Nursing and Allied Health Program objectives; educational level, track and topic; number of same topic submissions; and *free of product/drug bias.*

Be sure to carefully follow the online directions when submitting presentation proposals. The submission form includes attachments that must be completed for the proposal to be considered.

Any incomplete proposal will be disqualified. It is the responsibility of the submitter to assure the online proposal is complete.
