## Call for 2019 NAON Congress Podium and Poster Presentation Proposals

### Welcome to Congress 2019!

The NAON Congress Unit invites you to submit a podium or poster presentation proposal for the 39<sup>th</sup> Annual Congress in Atlanta, GA. NAON's Congress provides an open learning environment and a wide variety of modalities and viewpoints. Priority is given to interprofessional collaborative education for podium sessions and for posters. Perspectives from nurses, physicians, nurse practitioners, therapists, case managers/navigators add value to the education.

### Congress Learner Outcomes

Please consider the following NAON Congress learner outcomes when developing a proposal:

- Implement practice changes based on evidence-based practice, professional development and research in the care of the orthopaedic patient.
- Impact patient outcomes through adoption of best practices and innovation.
- Contribute to a professional environment that encourages collegiality and networking among participants associated with advancement in orthopaedic nursing education, practice, and research.

The ongoing Congress goal is for at least 70% of presentations to be educational level 3 and ONCB-designated category A. NAON promotes a progressive, evidence-based educational experience and supports orthopaedic nursing certification requirements. All podium and poster presentations must be evidence-based, rather than anecdotal, and must generate *new* knowledge for participants.

Be sure to carefully follow the online directions when submitting presentation proposals. Any incomplete proposal will be disqualified. It is the responsibility of the submitter to assure the online proposal is complete.

### Submission Deadlines:

**Podium Presentation Proposals are due by [July 6, 2018](#)**

*(There will be no extension date; notification of acceptance/decline by late September 2018).*

**Poster Presentation Proposals are due by [September 14, 2018](#)**

*(There will be no extension date; notification of acceptance/decline by late November 2018)*

### Podium Presentation Proposals

Podium presentation proposals require:

- A Title
- Learner Need or Practice Gap
- Detailed Summary of Content
- Learner Outcome/Objectives
- Minimum of 3 references

Research podium proposals *additionally* require background, problem and purpose, methodology, sample, results, limitations, conclusions, and implications. *A research study **must be completed** before submitting it as a podium proposal.*

### Poster Presentation Proposals

Poster presentation proposals require a title, purpose, one outcome ("The learner will..."), and summary of the content. Research poster proposals require the above AND background, problem, methodology, sample size, results, limitations, conclusions, and implications. *A research study **must be completed** before submitting a research poster proposal.*

### All Presentation Proposals

There can be no more than 2 physical presenters per poster or 3 physical presenters per podium presentation. Proposals are considered using the following criteria: proposal appearance and completion; outcomes/objectives and content; innovation; evidence-based; relevance to orthopaedic nursing; support for Congress learner outcomes; educational level, track and topic; number of same topic submissions; category A or B; and free of product/drug bias.

A proposal can be for either a podium or poster presentation, but not both. **To be considered, the presentation or poster cannot have any bias or product promotion.**

Travel and housing arrangements are the responsibility of each presenter.
